Nomination Procedures

The following positions are open for nominations, as specified in the proposed Bylaws:

Officers and voting members of the Board of Directors:

- Chair
- Chair-elect
- Past-Chair
- Treasurer
- Webmaster
- Secretary

Up to Five voting Members-at-Large of the Board of Directors

If you wish to nominate someone for one of these 11 open positions, you must first check with that person to be sure he or she is willing to serve. You can nominate yourself.

Nominations can be made either in advance or from the floor at the Annual Meeting. Nominations in advance must be made via email to Donghong Sun <dsunchem@gmail.com>, Interim Secretary and Chair of the Nominating Committee. Individuals nominated in advance are strongly encouraged (but are not required) to submit a brief bio to the Interim Secretary. A list of the names of those nominated with any submitted bios will be distributed to the membership via email before the Annual Meeting and in print at the Annual meeting. Candidates for all positions must be members of STEMteachersNYC, to be determined by the membership list of the STEMteachersNYC GoogleGroup.

Nominations made from the floor at the Annual Meeting must be seconded. Individuals nominated from the floor at the Annual Meeting must agree to stand for election immediately after the nomination is seconded or the nomination is invalid. All nominated candidates will have time to make a short statement about their candidacy before the voting is conducted.
